

FOOTBALL LEGEND JOHNNY GILES HOLDS LEEDS PRESS LAUNCH AT FORD & WARREN

Last night Ford & Warren Solicitors played host to Leeds United legend John 'Johnny' Giles as he launched his autobiography 'A Football Man'. After the main launch, which took place in his home town of Dublin, Ireland last week, Johnny also decided to come back to the city which had made him a football star and the law firm that represented him two years ago.

Back in 2008, Ford & Warren represented John Giles in a winning High Court legal dispute over an acclaimed novel chronicling the late Brian Clough's 44 day reign as Leeds manager; *The Damned United*.

Now aged 70, The Leeds United Legend has released his own autobiography 'A Football Man'. In the book Giles discusses his time at Elland Road during the glory years, starting with his arrival in the early 1960s. He also attempts to set the record straight on the Leeds side of the time that has come in for heavy criticism as 'Dirty Leeds'.

John Giles chose the Leeds City Centre law firm as his Leeds Press Launch venue where he did a reading and took questions from attendees, as well as took the time to meet with Ford & Warren employees and sign copies of his book.
